In a broad practise, Conroy's original source material is drawn from the creative output of others, both professionals and amateurs, from literature or art, blog articles or YouTube clips. His aim is not to usurp ownership but rather to engage with those artists and run alongside them in an effort to investigate the role and importance of mediating material, particularly introductions, interpretations and presentations. Conroy is interested in the role of the fan, the pundit, and the enthusiast, and how one engages with their opinions in relation to one's own, if it is possible to separate the two. With few works looking alike, pieces manifest themselves as video, found objects, found drawings authored by others, performance and constructions.
